A pioneer agreement

- First bilateral agreement between the governments of **Switzerland and Peru** for the **acquisition of ITMOs* in the world** under Article 6.2 of the Paris Agreement.
- First **Article 6.2 agreement in Peru**: improved cookstove technology.

Currently, the program has financing for **40,000 ICS***, and is seeking financing for an additional **20,000 ICS**. The objective is to be able to have the greatest possible impact on the rural communities.
